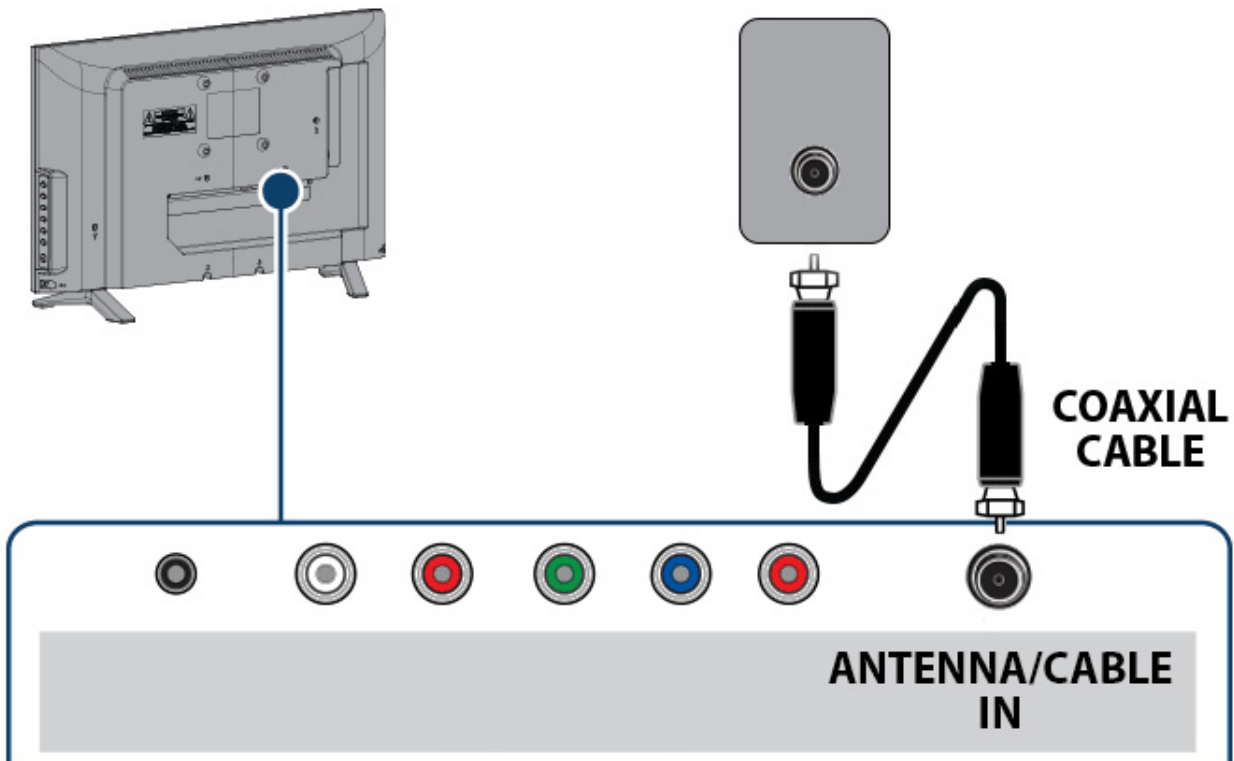

Connect your TV to the antenna



1. Connect a coaxial cable (aka RG6 cable) to the wall outlet.
2. Connect the other end of the coaxial cable to the **ANTENNA/CABLE IN** port on the back of your TV.
3. Scan for channels.

NOTE: The process to scan channels is specific to your brand of TV. Please refer to the TV manufacturer guide or search for “channel scan” and the brand of your TV (ex. Vizio channel scan). For general instructions: Change TV input to TV/Antenna. Select TV Menu, navigate to Settings > Tuner and ENTER. In Tuner Settings, select and enter “Auto Channel Scan.”





#1 Most Important Tip for Cutting the Cord

You get the benefit of watching ~80 channels of local network TV for free because of the provided antenna in your building. Instead of paying for expensive cable bundles, choose a micro-bundle of cable channels that suits your needs for as low as \$7/month.
