
Connect your TV to the antenna

60+ channels of TV for FREE



1. Connect a coaxial cable (aka RG6 cable) to the wall outlet.
2. Connect the other end of the coaxial cable to the **ANTENNA/CABLE IN** port on the back of your TV.
3. Scan for channels.

NOTE: The process to scan channels is specific to your brand of TV. Please refer to the TV manufacturer guide or search for “channel scan” and the brand of your TV (ex. Vizio channel scan). For general instructions: Change TV input to TV/Antenna. Select TV Menu, navigate to Settings > Tuner and ENTER. In Tuner Settings, select and enter “Auto Channel Scan.”





#1 Most Important Tip for Cutting the Cord

You get the benefit of watching ~60 channels of local network TV for free because of the provided antenna in your building. Instead of paying for expensive cable bundles, choose a micro-bundle of cable channels that suits your needs for as low as \$7/month. Troubleshooting Tips

If you are experiencing TV Antenna issues and installed a basic antenna by itself, 99% of issues are easy to fix and are related to user error or your TV, not the antenna. Usually, the issue can easily be fixed by changing the TV input or rescanning for channels.

1. Change TV Input.

If you have no picture or the TV screen is black. First, make sure your TV is plugged into a live power outlet. Next, ensure the TV's source or input is on "TV" to receive the Free TV Antenna channels. You can do this by clicking the SOURCE or INPUT button on your remote control or on the TV itself, until you see your Free TV Antenna channels again.

2. Scan for Channels.

If you are having any antenna issues or are missing channels or just want to look for new channels on your Free TV Antenna - rescan! We recommend you refer to your TV's instruction manual or user guide for precise instructions. If you do not have your instruction manual handy, you can typically download it from the manufacturer's website. Every TV and remote is different, but you will need your original TV remote. First make sure your TV is on the input or source of "TV" (see # 1 above). Next, click "MENU" or "SETUP" to display TV settings. On some TVs you will need to select "Antenna" "Air" "OTA" on the TV Settings page. Finally hit the "Scan" or "Channel Scan" option.

3. Fix Reception or Pixelation.

If our experts installed an outdoor antenna, rest assured you will be getting all of the major networks in awesome HD! However some TVs have a poor digital TV tuner in them which can cause issues. There are also smaller low powered Free TV channels and channels further away that might have issues with interference which cannot be guaranteed.
